Subject: Additional Services for Children IEP/IFSP

Policy:

The Head Start/Early Head Start program will participate in the implementation of an Individualized Education Plan (IEP) and Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP) for children with Disabilities.

Procedure:

- 1. Head Start/Early Head Start staff members and parents will attend Admission, Review, Dismissal meeting, Individualized Education Plan (IEP) meetings, and /or Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP) meetings.
- 2. The Local Education Agency/Early Steps will invite Head Start/Early Head Start staff and parents to participate in the IEP/IFSP meeting.
- 3. In cooperation with LEA/Early Steps, Head Start/Early Head Start staff and parents will assist with the IEP/IFSP process for children with a suspected disability. The appropriate service will be determined by the IEP/IFSP team.
- 4. The services for a child with disabilities will be delivered as required by the IEP/IFSP.
- 5. The staff and the appropriate agency will work with children to meet their goals in their IEP/IFSP.
- 6. Every effort will be made to ensure the disabilities children received their services at the Early Head Start/Head Start center.
- 7. In cooperation with Early Steps, Early Head Start staff and parents will assist with the transition process for children with an IFSP to ensure the appropriate steps are taken in a timely manner to determine the child's eligibility for services under Part B of the IDEA.
- 8. For children with an IEP that are transitioning out of Head Start to kindergarten, collaboration with the LEA, parent, and Head Start staff will ensure steps are taken in a timely and appropriate manner to support the child and family as they transition to a new setting.
