Subject: Animals on Site

Policy:

Animals will not be permissible at any Head Start/Early Head Start center unless properly immunized. Fish and birds will be the only animals on site.

Procedure:

- 1. Animals must be properly immunized, free from disease, and clean.
- 2. Parents must be informed in writing of all animals on the premises. Such information may be provided by way of a conspicuously posted notice or bulletin, policy handbook, parent flier, or a statement included on the enrollment form.
- 3. Documentation of current immunizations must be available for review upon request by the licensing authority.
- 4. Children must wash their hands after feeding the fish.
- 5. Fish tanks must be cleaned as needed.
- 6. Birds will be allowed on site with the following instructions:
 - A) Birds will not be handled by children, staff, or volunteers at any time.
 - B) If birds cause any allergy to be triggered, birds will be removed from classroom.
 - C) Must be posted at entrance way of classroom that bird is on site and is only to look at and not to touch.
 - D) Skirting will be kept around cage to catch dander. The cage will be cleaned as needed.
- 7. There must be a designated member of staff who will be responsible for the cleaning of the cages and tank.
