Subject: Comprehensive Services

Policy:

Tri-County Community Council will provide a full range of comprehensive services that includes Education and Child Development, Health, Family and Community Engagement, Children with Disabilities, and Transition program services. The only exception is for Early Head Start Home-Based, and the exception is in Education and Child Development 1302.30 through 1302.32 and Family and Community Engagement 1302.34.

Procedure:

1. Head Start center-based and Early Head Start center and home-based children will receive the full range of comprehensive services with the exception listed above.
2. Plans and policies will be developed to ensure that the full range of comprehensive services listed above is being implemented to meet the needs of the children and their families.
