## **Policy**:

Early Head Start Home-based will use Partnering for Healthy Babies, Creative Curriculum for Infants, Toddlers, & Twos, and Creative Curriculum Guide for Home Visitors for home visiting and socialization.

## **Procedure:**

- 1. The home visitor will use the curriculums to promote the parent's role as the child's teacher through experiences that focus on the parent-child relationship as appropriate, and the family's traditional culture, values, and beliefs.
- 2. The home visitor will use the curriculum's developmental scopes and sequences that include plans and materials for learning experiences based on developmental progression and how children learn.
- 3. The home visitor will use the Teaching Strategies GOLD assessment tool to track the child's progress.
- 4. The Coach/Education Specialist will support staff in the implementation of the curriculum and provide supportive feedback.
- 5. The Education Coordinator will supervise the continuous improvement through training and professional development of the home visitor.
- 6. The home visitor will review the Home-based Curriculums (Partnering for Healthy Babies and Creative Curriculum: Infants, Toddlers, & Twos and Creative Curriculum Guide for Home Visitor) and the instructional materials with parents during enrollment.
