Policy

Mental health services must be secured by contracting with a mental health consultant. The consultant will provide the program with classroom observations, assist the program with implementing strategies that promote positive mental health and social-emotional functioning. The consultant will also assist the program with addressing behavioral and mental health concerns.

Procedure

- 1. Service contracts will be updated annually for mental health services through a contracted agency or individual.
- 2. Consent for classroom observation by a social-emotional development professional should be attained at enrollment.
- 3. A signed mental health observation permission form is needed before any individual observations of a child are made. Although, observations can be made of children while the classroom is being observed.
- 4. The mental health consultant will provide information and assistance with identifying situations that require further treatment or the modification of the program to meet the needs of the child.
- 5. Information from the mental health consultant will be shared with the parents upon request.
- 6. Staff will solicit assistance from a mental health consultant to access all existing resources as needed and to locate a provider for any child and family services that are outside of the consultant's scope of support.
- 7. Staff will work with a mental health consultant to secure appropriate services through referrals as needed. Staff will ensure that appropriate follow-ups are conducted to ensure that the family is able to access services.
- 8. All referrals and assistance to the family will be documented in the Family File.
