## **Policy:**

All children will be dressed appropriately according to the weather when going outdoors and will be protected from insect-borne disease.

## **Procedure:**

- 1. All children will be dressed appropriately according to the weather.
- 2. If the weather is at 90 degrees or above, outside time can be reduced.
- 3. If the weather is at 40 degrees or below, outside time can be reduced.
- 4. If the temperature falls below 30 degrees, the Health Services Coordinator will make a determination to allow outside activities. The Health Services Coordinator will contact centers via telephone on the decisions (as needed).
- 5. The Health Services Coordinator will work together with the local Health Departments to ensure knowledge of any insect-borne activity.
- 6. Children will be monitored at all times for heat or cold protection.
- 7. If the wind chill factor is 30 degrees or below, outside activities must be brought inside to encourage physical activity. Examples: bouncy balls, sack race, parachute, and freeze dancing.
