Policy

The Tri-County Head Start/Early Head Start Program will make every effort to ensure accommodations are made to make all programs and facilities more accessible for all children.

Procedure

- 1. No child is discriminated against on the sole basis of a disability, however special arrangements may be required to facilitate certain limitations.
- 2. Transportation will be provided through contracts with Tri-County Community Council Transportation for the disadvantaged, contingent upon funding availability.
- 3. All transportation regulations will be adhered to, and escorts will be provided by Head Start.
- 4. Special equipment and materials will be provided for use in the program as needed when requested by a therapist or physician.
- 5. Requests for special equipment must be submitted to the Disability Specialist.
- 6. Staff will receive instruction on a child's use of special equipment to be used for therapeutic purposes.
