Policy

The Tri-County Head Start/Early Head Start Program will make every effort to ensure accommodations are made to make all programs and facilities more accessible for all children.

Procedure

1. No child is discriminated against on the sole basis of a disability, however special arrangements may be required to facilitate certain limitations.
2. Transportation will be provided through contracts with Tri-County Community Council Transportation for the disadvantaged, contingent upon funding availability.
3. All transportation regulations will be adhered to, and escorts will be provided by Head Start.
4. Special equipment and materials will be provided for use in the program as needed when requested by a therapist or physician.
5. Requests for special equipment must be submitted to the Disability Specialist.
6. Staff will receive instruction on a child's use of special equipment to be used for therapeutic purposes.
